Garden of Feedin'

HandsOn Broward partners with early childhood learning facilities in marginalized communities to provide hands-on nutrition education and gardening experiences for pre-school aged children.



- Currently serving 13 sites
- Program includes nutrition-focused curriculum
- AmeriCorps members train school staff annually as facilitators and leaders.

Comcast/OneEconomy Digital Connectors Program

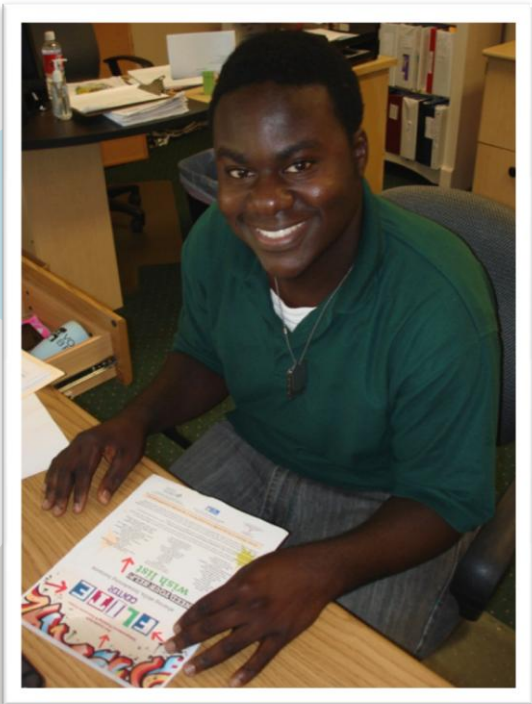
The Digital Connectors Program is offered to at-promise youth, ages 13-18, looking to serve their communities through technology and leadership.

- National youth program sponsored by OneEconomy
- HOB currently engages 20 youth
- At the end of the program, youth will be Cisco Certified and will have an opportunity to intern at Comcast.



Transitional Independent Living Internships

HandsOn Broward offers 10-week internships to foster youth who are transitioning from the state's care to a life of independence .



- 20 hours a week for 10 weeks
- Interns gain customer service, computer, project leader and employability skills
- Primary goal is to create, manage and lead a service project to benefit a Broward County nonprofit organization

Emergency Preparedness & Response

HandsOn Broward is recognized as a leader in Florida's Emergency Support Function 15 (ESF 15) – Volunteers and Donations – in the aftermath of a natural or manmade disaster.

- Manages unaffiliated, spontaneous volunteers to meet the needs of those organizations and individuals impacted
- Monthly trainings hosted throughout the region



Economic Outreach, Development and Recovery

- **Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)**
 - HOB initiated The Broward VITA Collaborative to standardize the EITC/VITA program across the county and ensure sustainability
 - HOB's role in the coalition includes volunteer recruitment and retention, IRS certification training and outreach



- **Hands On Finance**

- Engages skills-based volunteers to provide financial literacy workshops that teach youth about the importance of budgeting, understanding spending habits and using credit.

Corporate Volunteer Services

HOB identifies volunteer projects that suit organizational goals and project requirements of socially responsible companies who seek to engage their employees in the Broward County community.

- Consults with corporate contacts to identify impact and match with community need
- Manages site visits, logistics and day-of needs
- Provides impact measures and outcomes
- Implements social and traditional media strategies throughout all phases
